

HOOD & CHUTE CLEANER -

Signs and Symptoms of Overexposure (Chronic): None

Medical conditions aggravated by overexposure: Sensitive skin

Carcinogen or Suspect Carcinogen Ingredients: None

Emergency and First Aid Procedures:

Eyes: Can cause permanent eye injury. Symptoms include stinging, tearing, redness, and swelling of eyes. Flush eyes for 15 minutes and get medical attention.

Skin: Can cause permanent skin damage. Symptoms may include redness, burning and swelling of skin, burns and other skin damage. Irritation may not occur until several hours after the exposure. Additional symptoms: hair loss, passage of this material into the body through the skin is possible. Remove contaminated clothing immediately; wash with soap and water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

Ingestion: Swallowing this material may be harmful or fatal. Symptoms include severe stomach and intestinal irritation (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea) abdominal pain and vomiting blood. Swallowing this material may cause burns and destroy tissue in the mouth, throat, and digestive tract. Low blood pressure and shock may occur as a result of severe tissue injury. Seek immediate medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth of with water and give milk or water to drink. Do not leave individual unattended.

Inhalation: Breathing this material may be harmful or fatal. Symptoms include: severe irritation and burns to the nose, throat and respiratory tract. Remove to fresh air. If irritation persists, get medical attention. Keep person warm and quiet. If person is not breathing begin artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult administer oxygen.
